Code Enforcement

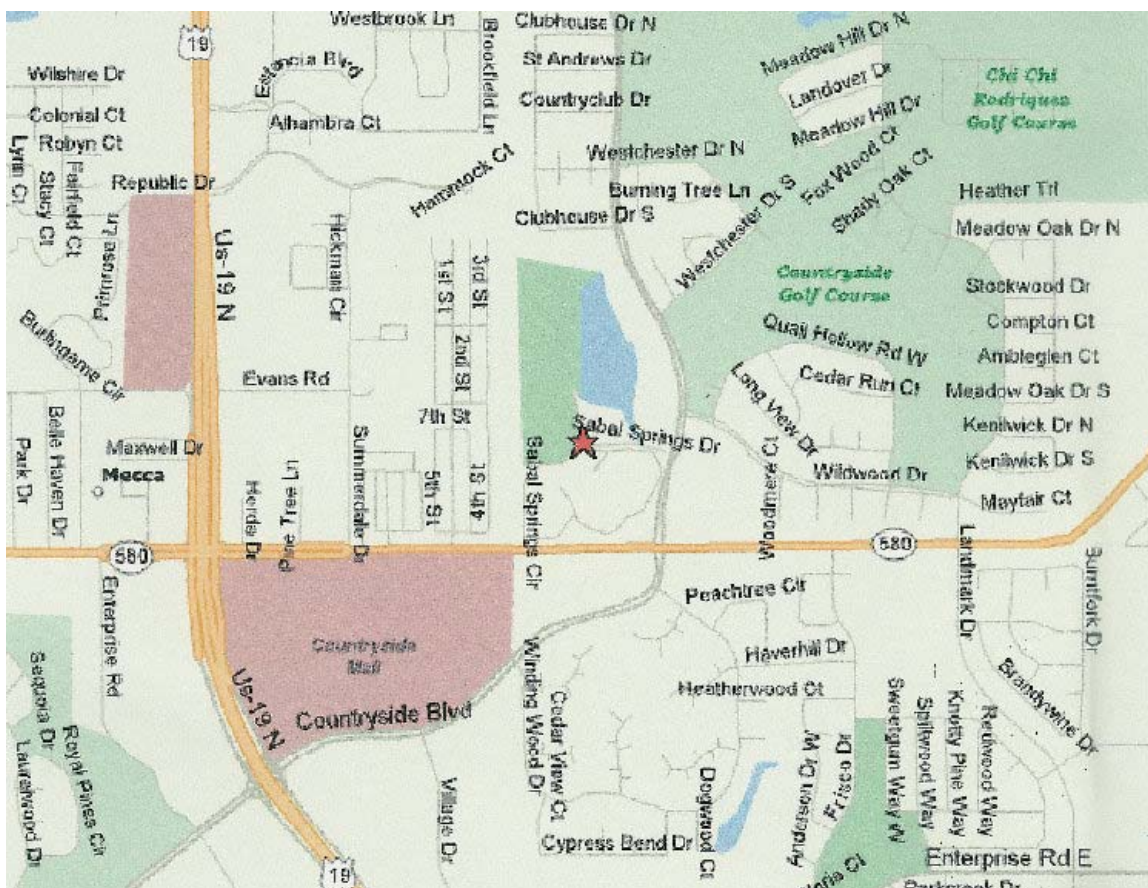
